DR HUGH VAUGHAN LECTURE

A distinguished vitreoretinal surgeon and clinical researcher, Dr Matthew Cunningham brings extensive expertise in advanced retinal disease management, surgical innovation, and ophthalmic education.

Dr Matthew Cunningham is a vitreoretinal surgeon and clinical research leader, currently serving as a partner at the Florida Retina Institute,

where he also directs clinical trials and research initiatives. Known for his commitment to advancing retinal care, his work spans surgical innovation, academic contribution, and physician education.

Born in New York and raised in South Florida, Dr Cunningham began his academic journey at the University of Miami, studying biomedical engineering before entering the accelerated Junior Honors Medical Program at the University of Florida. He earned both his Bachelor of Science degree and medical degree from the University of Florida College of Medicine, graduating cum laude with Honors in Research. During this time, he conducted research at the National Eye Institute's Laboratory of Ocular Immunology and was inducted into the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society, receiving the Romrell Professionalism in Medicine Award.

He completed his internship and ophthalmology residency at Baylor College of Medicine, where he was recognized with the Goar Award for resident research. He then pursued fellowship training in vitreoretinal surgery and diseases at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics, earning both the P.J. Leinfelder Award for outstanding research and the Fellow Award for Teaching Excellence.



DR MATTHEW CUNNINGHAM

In addition to his clinical and research roles, Dr Cunningham contributes actively to the field as an oral examiner and examination writer for the American Board of Ophthalmology. His work reflects a dedication to advancing both the science and practice of ophthalmology while mentoring the next generation of specialists.

DR DENIS DEGAZON LECTURE

A leading vitreoretinal surgeon and clinical researcher, Dr Chin Yee is recognized for his expertise in complex retinal disease and his commitment to advancing patient care through innovation, education, and service both in the United States and his native Jamaica.

Dr Chin Yee was born and raised in Jamaica before moving to the United States at the age of 16. He began his academic journey at the University of Miami, where he graduated summa cum laude, and went on to earn his medical degree from the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine. He completed his residency at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit, followed by a fellowship in medical and surgical retina at Washington University School of Medicine in St. Louis and Barnes Hospital.

Dr Chin Yee is a dedicated and compassionate vitreoretinal surgeon based in Atlanta, where he practices with Georgia Retina. Deeply committed to service, he regularly returns to Jamaica to provide surgical care and volunteers locally by offering quarterly vision and eye health screenings for refugee communities at Grace Village.

In addition to his clinical work, Dr Chin Yee is an active leader in ophthalmology. He serves as Assistant Professor at Mercer University School of Medicine, Vice President of the Atlanta Ophthalmology Society, Chief of Ophthalmology at Northside Hospital, and Director of Clinical Research at Georgia Retina.

A respected contributor to the field, Dr Chin Yee has led and participated in numerous clinical trials and has authored a wide range of scientific publications covering topics such as diabetic retinopathy, macular degeneration, central serous chorioretinopathy, and ocular histoplasmosis.



DR DAVID CHIN YEE

He also holds an invention disclosure with the University of Miami for an innovative eye drop holder. His expertise is frequently sought at national conferences, where he lectures on retinal disease and surgical advancements, and he has served as a peer reviewer for leading journals including Ophthalmology, RETINA, and Ophthalmic Surgery, Lasers and Imaging.

Dr Valence A. Jordan is a graduate of the DM Ophthalmology programme at the University of the West Indies and a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of Glasgow.

Dr Ronnie Bhola is a vitreoretinal surgeon based in Trinidad, with subspecialty training in vitreous and retina surgery in the United Kingdom. He completed his MBBS at the University of the West Indies and returned home in 2008, where he practices across both public and private sectors with a focus on cataract, complex intraocular, and retinal surgery. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Ophthalmologists and the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh.

Dr Bhola is actively involved in research and education, with over 50 peer-reviewed publications and extensive teaching of ophthalmology residents. He serves as Vice President of the Ophthalmological Society of the West Indies and holds additional leadership roles within regional and international ophthalmology.



DR KIM JEBODHSINGH

Dr Kim Jebodhsingh completed her MBBS at the University of the West Indies, followed by ophthalmology residency at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit and fellowship training in oculoplastic, lacrimal, and orbital surgery at the University of Toronto. She is dedicated to advancing access to high-quality eye care across Barbados and the Caribbean, with a focus on preventing visual impairment and blindness.

Dr Jebodhsingh is co-founder of the Caribbean Ophthalmology Research Alliance (CORA) and convenor of the annual “Latest Updates in Ophthalmology Subspecialty Conference” in Barbados. 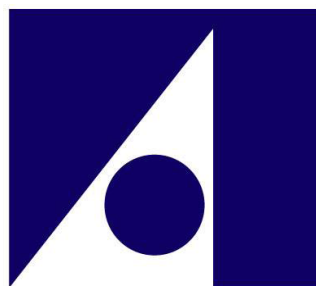
